



F-1 CHANGE OF PROGRAM

F-1 students who have changed their major field or level of study must obtain a new Form I-20 to reflect that change. A Change of Program includes changing your major (for example, from Arts and Sciences to Aerospace Engineering, Finance to Computer science, etc.) and starting a new degree program (for examples, from ESL program to undergraduate program, undergraduate program to MBA program, Master program to Ph.D. program, etc.).

Submit the following documents to the Office of International Services, located in DuBourg Hall 150, to obtain a new Form I-20.

Change your major: If you changed your major, we need the following:

- 1) A letter from your academic advisor stating that you are allowed to change from one major field of study to another.
- 2) An updated financial certification is necessary only if you need to extend your length of study due to the demand of your new major.

Change Your Degree Program: If you changed your degree, we need the following:

- 1) The acceptance letter of your new degree program.
- 2) An updated financial certification to cover the tuition and living expenses for the duration of the new program.
